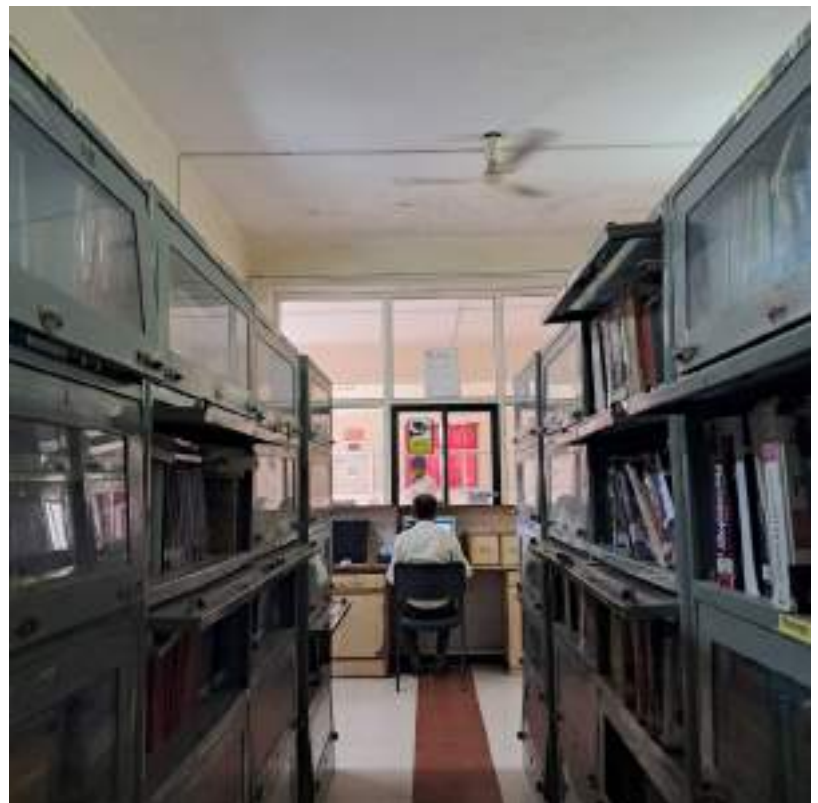

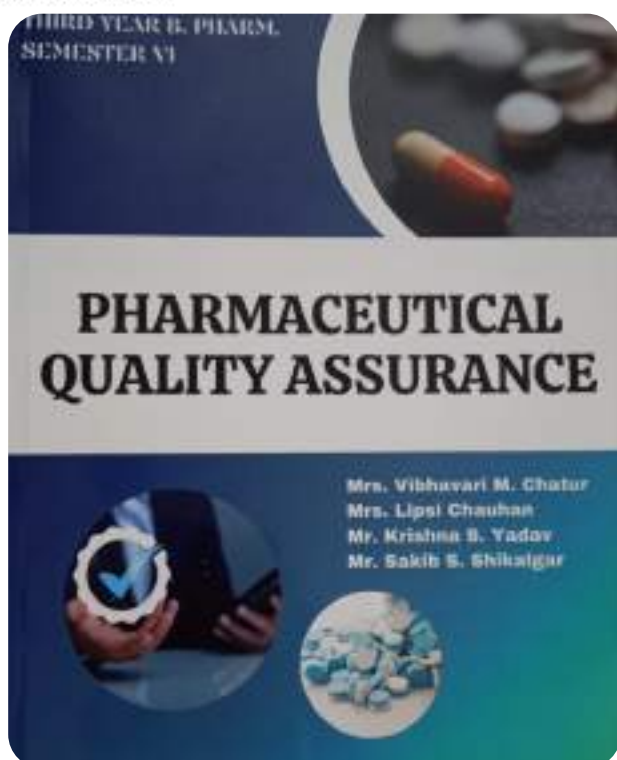
Design Registration Achievement: Innovation in Herbal Therapeutics

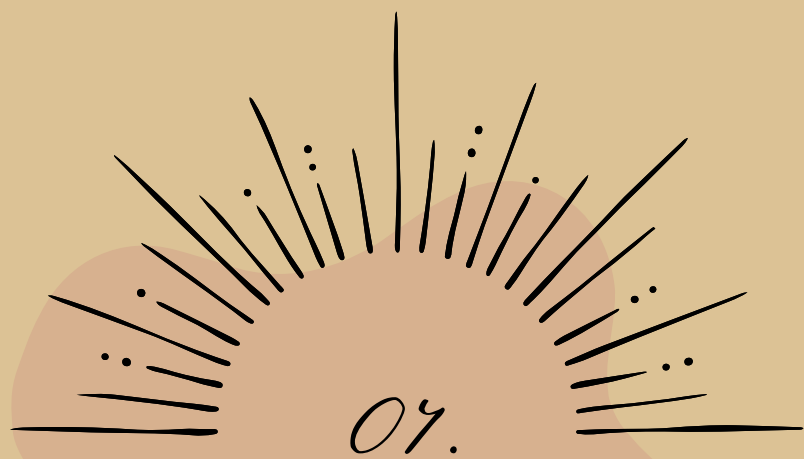

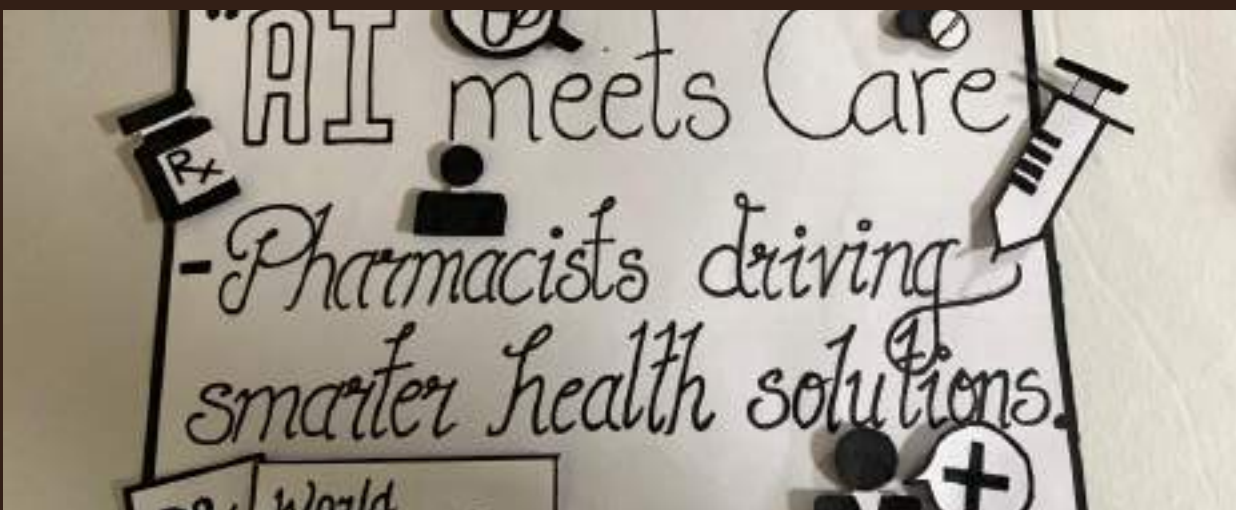
NSS CAMP 2024-25 AT KUSGAON, TAL. MAVAL, DIST. PUNE

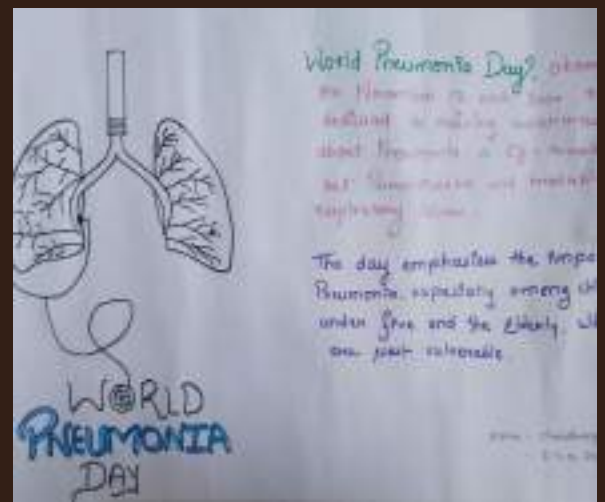
